COMMERCIAL RECYCLING PROGRAM

EAST MANCHESTER TOWNSHIP RECYCLING PROGRAM

East Manchester Township's Ordinance 2003-1 states that all residential, commercial and industrial establishments are required to participate in the Township's recycling program. **RECYCLING IS MANDATORY.**

The Township also requires each commercial establishment <u>submit a written report</u> with the number of tons of recyclables collected and recycled each year. Each year a copy of the required report is sent to all business' and institutional establishments. All are asked to report their yearly (previous calendar year) tonnage of recyclables to the Township office by **January 15th** of each year.

All business establishments are required to be in compliance with our recycling ordinance. Fines and penalties may be assessed for non-compliance.

RECYCLABLE ITEMS FOR BUSINESS

To be in compliance with Recycling Ordinance 2003-1, you must recycle the following materials:

- ALUMINUM, STEEL, AND BIMETAL FOOD AND BEVERAGE CONTAINERS
- PLASTIC BOTTLES, JUGS, AND JARS WITH NECK OR OPENING SMALLER THAN THE BASE OF THE CONTAINER i.e.: MILK JUGS, DETERGENT BOTTLES, SHAMPOO BOTTLES, WATER BOTTLES, PEANUT BUTTER JARS PLEASE REMOVE LIDS AND CAPS
- NEWSPRINT, MAGAZINES, AND PAPER INSERTS
- SHREDDED PAPER
- HIGH GRADE OFFICE PAPER
- CORRUGATED- CARDBOARD PLEASE FLATTEN
- BOXBOARD i.e.: CEREAL, SODA, PIZZA, SHOE, AND FOOD PACKAGING BOXES.
- CLEAR, GREEN, AND BROWN GLASS FOOD AND BEVERAGE CONTAINERS

All commercial and institutional establishments must provide written documentation to the Township of the total number of tons recycled.

PENALTY FOR VIOLATION

Failing to comply may result in penalties. For every violation or non-compliance one may be sentenced to pay a civil fine of no less than twenty - five dollars (\$25.00) and not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), costs of the suit and Township Attorney's fees. Each continuing day of violation shall be deemed a separate offense.

RECYCLING HAULERS

Any hauler, other than the designated hauler (Penn Waste), shall report tonnage collected from industrial commercial establishments to the Township.
