

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING PROGRAM

BULK ITEM COLLECTION

For residents receiving regular trash / recyclable collection service, your pick up service INCLUDES

ONE (1) bulk item per week.

Bulk item collection is provided during the same hours and days as your regular pick up service.

Large items to be collected include, but not limited to: refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers, water heaters, washing machines, dryers, freezers, TV's, chairs, rolled carpet, desks, tables, mattresses, box springs, bed frames, sofas, lawn mowers (no oil / gas), toilets, sinks, window screens, doors, and similar household items. Any items containing FREON must be called in to Customer Service at Penn Waste Ph. 717-767-4456 to schedule pick up. All other items go to the curbside with regular trash.

YARD AND LEAF WASTE

Yard waste such as tree trimmings or shrubbery may be placed for pick up on your scheduled trash day - during April to October. Contact Penn Waste at 717-767-4456 for more details.

Leaf Waste: The Township will pick up leaves in the fall. Leaves must be placed in piles along the edge of the road within the cartway or the berm. Branches or pet waste must not be mixed with the leaves. Do not put leaves in any containers.

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING PROGRAM

East Manchester Township's Ordinance 2003-1 states that all residential, commercial and industrial establishments are required to participate in the Township's recycling program. **RECYCLING IS MANDATORY.**

All residential recycling and trash services are provided to the Township by Penn Waste. All residents must participate in the program. If regular trash service is not used, you must obtain the orange trash bags, (one bag per quarter), at a cost of \$3.50 per bag. You must also recycle.

ON ANOTHER NOTE

Remember when fertilizing your lawn that excess fertilizers can be washed into the nearest stream or storm sewer system and ultimately the Chesapeake Bay. These excess fertilizers can cause large algae blooms, which use up a lot of oxygen. This oxygen is essential for the fish and other aquatic life to live in the bay. If you fertilize, please follow directions and use sparingly.

RECYCLABLE ITEMS FOR RESIDENTIAL

To be in compliance with Recycling Ordinance 2003-1, *you must recycle the following materials:*

- ALUMINUM, STEEL, AND BIMETAL FOOD AND BEVERAGE CONTAINERS
- AEROSOL CANS **MUST BE EMPTY**
- PLASTIC BOTTLES, JUGS, AND JARS WITH NECK OR OPENING SMALLER THAN THE BASE OF THE CONTAINER
i.e.: MILK JUGS, DETERGENT BOTTLES, SHAMPOO BOTTLES, WATER BOTTLES, PEANUT BUTTER JARS
PLEASE REMOVE LIDS AND CAPS.
- NEWSPRINT, MAGAZINES, PAPER INSERTS, PHONE BOOKS, AND JUNK MAIL
- HIGH - GRADE OFFICE PAPER AND SHREDDED PAPER
- CORRUGATED - CARDBOARD **PLEASE FLATTEN**
- BOXBOARD i.e.: CEREAL, SODA, PIZZA, SHOE, AND FOOD PACKAGING BOXES. **PLEASE FLATTEN**
- CLEAR, GREEN, AND BROWN GLASS FOOD AND BEVERAGE CONTAINERS
