



Impacted by the recent storm?

The York County Office of Emergency Management is asking property owners to file damage reports to assess impact, provide resources, and begin recovery. Reportable damages include: downed trees, structure damage, foundation collapse, water in basements and living areas, private lane and bridge washouts, loss of personal belongings, water-logged appliances and utilities.

After damages are recorded and evaluated, financial assistance in the form of grants and low interest loans MAY be available if the county qualifies to get financial help from the state or the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).
