Discussion of Summer Roadway Repairs and Ride-Along with Public Works Director

The public works director and the three board members met to do their annual roads inspection of the township. This is done once a year to inspect the roads and discuss upcoming summer projects.

Part of Willow Springs Lane and all of Gravel Hill Road were discussed for pavement overlay. When the I-83 Exit 26 interchange begins, Willow Springs Lane should be extended across to Espresso Way. The Board agrees they do not want to cul-de-sac Willows Springs Lane.

Sections of Catalina Drive and Greenwood Estates were discussed to mill existing pavement and repave. Loucks Street, Sunset Lane and Devco Drive were discussed for micro surface.

Discussions were also had to extend Bartlett Drive to Zions View Road. The Bartlett Drive extension should start after Hillwood's portion of Canal Road Betterment is complete. Hillwood's improvements involve Canal Road/Zions View Road to the Locust Point Road bridge.

After all Township Roads were reviewed, Mr. Haugh and the three Board members toured local businesses and upcoming building sites.
